IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL! 😊😊😊

“Meet the Teacher/Back to School Night” will not be in-person this year. Go to www.stpaulsenid.com and click on the School Link and then the Meet the Teacher Link. By 5:30PM on Tuesday, August 11, we will post your teacher's welcome video!

First Day of School – We are so excited to welcome our students back on Thursday, August 13, 2020. It will look a little different this year, but we are all in this together and we know with God's help, we will have a great year!

PreKindergarten and Kindergarten students: We will use our alley located on the north side of the building for arrival and dismissal. Students may arrive between 8:00-8:15AM. PreK students may have one adult accompany them to the classroom for the first couple of days or until they feel comfortable. Kindergarten parents will need to say their goodbyes at the top of the stairs. We will have a sign that says **“Check in Here”** at the top of the stairs in the alley where your child's temperature will be taken. Children with temperatures above 100 degrees will be asked to stay at home until they are fever free (without the use of fever reducing medicine) for 48 hours and no other symptoms develop. Students will bring all their supplies the first day of school. We are asking students to wear their own mask into the building and then they will be given a uniform blue mask to wear at school anytime they leave the classroom and are in the common areas/hallways. The blue mask will be left at school. When picking up your PreK or Kindergarten students at 3:25PM each day, please park in an alley parking space and exit your car to pick up your child from his/her teacher. Those students who have older siblings will be brought by their teacher to the south parking lot to meet their parents there.

Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5: We will use the front south parking lot for arrival and dismissal. Students may arrive between 8:00-8:15AM. We are asking parents to stay in their cars and wait for the teacher at the **“Check in Here”** sign to come to your car where your child's temperature will be taken while still in the car. Children with temperatures above 100 degrees will be asked to stay at home until they are fever free (without the use of fever reducing medicine) for 48 hours and no other symptoms develop. Students will bring all their supplies the first day of school. We are asking students to wear their own mask into the building and then they will be given a uniform blue mask to wear at school anytime they leave the classroom and are in the common areas/hallways. The blue masks will be left at school. At 3:30PM each day, each class will be lined up on the grass area on the south side of the school. We will have the same car lines as we have in the past. Your child/ren will stay in their class lines until you pull up to the small gate.

BEFORE CARE AND AFTER CARE: Our Before Care begins at 7:00AM each day. Please bring your child to the double red doors by the front office and the caretaker will take your child's temperature as they enter the building. Before Care and After Care will both be held in the all-purpose room this year to allow for social distancing. They will still have snacks as usual and play outside whenever possible. Pick up is no later than 5:30PM.

Thank you parents for being flexible and for understanding how important your child's safety is to us. We appreciate your patience and prayers as we work through this “new” system.
