I am excited with the group of young people who are attending our Youth Group meetings as they are anxious to be involved and to learn. I am working hard to develop various activities to provide fun and discipleship building experiences for our youth. I do have one couple interested in assisting with the Youth Group, and they will begin working with me soon.

As announced in Youth Group and prior to Sunday worship, we have a group going to Lutherhoma the week of July 11 – 16, 2021. There are two camps that week that enables all our youth from ages 9 through 15 to attend the same week.

The cost for the camp is \$400.00 if you do early registration. St. Paul's will pay 50% of that fee. For those who are unable to afford camp, but would like to go, I have donors willing to step up and pay the balance of the fee for you. Any child who desires to go will be able to do so. Please contact Pastor Reber if you need assistance.

Therefore, if your child desires to go to Camp Lutherhoma July 11-16, 2021, you need to go online, www.lutherhoma.com, and complete the registration. You will pay a \$50 deposit at that time. Then complete the paper form in the Lutherhoma brochure and return it to the office with the balance you are responsible for less the \$200 the church is paying. Your check should be made out to St. Paul's and we will send a single check to Lutherhoma for all the campers. We need this completed by May 10, so the church can prepare the final balance for payment to Lutherhoma by May 15th.

I pray your children join us for Youth Group, grades 6 through 12, and that they are offered the opportunity to attend Camp Lutherhoma, ages 9-15. May God be with you all.
