Volunteers range in age from 13-96 and assignments are based on your ability. The mission of the float committee has been to provide a Christian witness and a message of hope in Jesus Christ, to the un-churched, who view the float in person or through other media.

After a day of float building, we can return to the hotel with knowledge that we were God's arms and hands in the work of proclaiming the gospel to 450 million people worldwide.
