Chancel Circle

The women in Chancel Circle care for and launder the communion linens, provide baptism napkins, wash the communion chalice and communion trays after services, change the altar cloths with the correct liturgical colors and dry clean them as needed, handle flowers on the altar, fill the candles with oil and trim the wicks, support and do various community work during the year in the community.

Community Service Circle

The women in Community Service Circle clean and care for the toys, cribs and linens of the nursery. They keep cleaning and sanitizing supplies in the nursery, schedule nursery attendants for the second worship service., and support and do various community work during the year in the community.
